User Guide for Inspection Permit Requirements Relating to **RESIDENTIAL ELECTRICAL UPGRADE**

PERMIT LIMITATION: This permit is only for a single inspection to upgrade the main electrical service on a single family residence.

PERMIT APPLICATION: The owner or contractor must complete and sign "Application to Construct Worksheet" (Form No. 284-500) Application can be processed at the front counter or through the permit online system: PLUS Online.

INSPECTION REQUIREMENTS: The following requirements listed below, but not limited to, will be verified at inspection.

1. Access to the structure shall be provided on the date of requested inspection and property address shall be conspicuously posted.
2. Job card and plot plan shall be posted at the main service panel.
3. The installation of all electrical equipment shall be complete at the time of inspection.
4. The location of water and gas pipe bonding must be accessible and available for visual inspection by building inspector.

NOTE 1 Failure to provide the above listed requirements at inspection may necessitate the applicant to obtain a reinspection fee.

NOTE 2 When intending to use the existing service panel as a junction box, please refer to CEC 110.3 *"modifying a listed product from it's original listing will necessitate the re-certification of the product by a third-party testing agency, specifically for the new intended use"*.
