### POOL FINAL INSPECTION ONLY

Pool final only permits are issued to complete pool permits, which have previously expired. This permit can only be used after all inspections under the original were approved with the exception of pool barrier and final. The following items must be brought to current minimum code standards:

- Form 284-004 Barriers For Swimming Pools, Spas And Hot Tubs; a copy of the new letter must be attached and signed by the home owner with all fencing clearly identified on approved site plan.
- GFCI protected lights, wet rated/tamper resistant, receptacles and pump motors (2019 CEC Sec 680.22)
- Bubble-type exterior rated covers on receptacles. Extra heavy duty. (2019 CEC Sec 406.9)
- Smoke and carbon monoxide sensors installed (2019 CRC Sec R314 and R315)
- All electrical to meet 2019 CEC code requirements (Riverside County ORD 457)

Please provide a site plan to scale, which identifies all setbacks from the pool to adjacent structures and pool equipment and property lines. The site plan must include all structures, pool equipment, pool and diagram of pool fencing to be used for compliance.
